### What are the facts?

1. A child born on 11 October 2009, is under 2 years when accepted for treatment on 6 October 2011.
2. The postcode for this patient is listed in our system in Scottish index of multiple deprivation (SIMD) area 4, and not in areas 1 - 3 as claimed. (note, the postcode is not detailed on the adjustment report).
3. The dentist has carried out both tooth brushing instruction (410301) and given dietary advice (410501). Both items are claimed on the form (neither item attracts a fee on its own, but both are needed for payment of the annual fee).

### How does our system adjust the payment?

1. The correct fee code for a child under 2 years of age, living in postcode SIMD area 4, is 410201, and replaces the claimed fee code of 410101 **d**. This initially reduces the payment from £21.25 to £11.00.
2. The fee for topical fluoride is then deleted **e** as this cannot be claimed for a child this age. This further reduces the payment from £11.00 to £5.00. The final payment **a** is authorised as tooth brushing instruction **b** and dietary advice **c** are given to the patient.

## What are the facts?

1. A child born on 19 October 2009, is under 2 years when accepted for treatment on 4 October 2011.
2. The child's postcode area is in SIMD area 2, when checked by our systems. The claim has been made for a SIMD area 1 - 3.
2. The dentist has carried out both tooth brushing instruction (410301) and given dietary advice (410501). Both items are claimed on the form (neither item attracts a fee on its own, but both are needed for payment of the annual fee).

## How does our system adjust the payment?

1. The fee for topical fluoride is deleted **d** as this cannot be claimed for a child this age. This reduces the payment from £21.25 to £15.25. The final payment **a** is authorised as tooth brushing instruction **b** and dietary advice **c** are given to the patient.

### What are the facts?

1. A child born on 31 December 2008, is over 2 years, but under 2 years 11 months when accepted for treatment on 6 October 2011.
2. The postcode for this patient is listed in our system in SIMD area 4, and not in areas 1 - 3 as claimed.  
(note, the postcode is not detailed on the adjustment report).
3. The dentist has carried out both tooth brushing instruction (410301) and given dietary advice (410501). Both items are claimed on the form (neither item attracts a fee on its own, but both are needed for payment of the annual fee).
4. Topical fluoride is not claimed by the dentist.

### How does our system adjust the payment?

1. The correct fee code for a child under 2 years and 11 months, living in postcode SIMD area 4, is 410201. This replaces the claimed fee code of 410101 **d**.  
The system reduces the payment from £15.25 to £5.00. The final payment **a** is authorised as tooth brushing instruction **b** and dietary advice **c** are given to the patient.
